

Vice Chairman Mark Cunningham called the special meeting on January 29, 2021 to order at 2:15 p.m. at the Fire Station. Trustees Cunningham and Heidecker were present at the Fire Station. Chairman Musto participated by teleconference. Fiscal Officer Mandie Andrews was also present at the Fire Station.

The purpose of the meeting was to decide the millage for the Road Improvement Levy that will be put on the May 4, 2021 ballot. Notice of the meeting was posted on the door of the Town Hall. Rural Urban Record reporter Blanche Nemeth was notified about the meeting but did not attend.

Two potential levies were discussed. The first levy was a Renewal of 1.00 mill plus 0.30 mills additional which would bring in \$319,000. The second levy was a Renewal of 1.00 mill plus 0.50 additional which would bring in \$374,284.

Motion Heidecker to put a 1.00 mill Renewal plus 0.30 mills additional levy for the purpose of Road Improvement on the May 4, 2021 ballot. Seconded Musto. Vote unanimous.




