ZONING INSPECTOR:

Permits – Zoning Inspector Bob Eichenberg did not issue any permits from December 16 through 31, 2020. In 2019, he issued permits for 43 new single-family homes.

Violations – Pat Metzger sent a copy of the property search done for the Toth property on Station Road. He has to do this by law in case anybody has a lien on the property. The property search came back good so now they can forward with trying to demo the house.

Zoning Commission – The Zoning Commission will meet on Thursday, January 9, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. They will hold a public hearing at 6:45 p.m. for Zoning Amendment 2019-04.

Board of Zoning Appeals – The next regularly scheduled BZA meeting is on January 27, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. since they did not receive any applications for their December meeting.

Subdivision Status - Eichenberg had nothing new to report.

MS4'S - No complaints or problems reported.

Department Input – Eichenberg reported the property at the corner of South Boone Road and SR82 has been cleaned up. The property owner was cutting firewood and now has all of it stacked up.

ROAD DEPARTMENT:

Equipment – Service Director Bob Rundle reported all equipment up and running.

Issue I – Rundle does not expect to hear anything new about Issue 1 until spring when the contractor is ready to do Redfern Road. This project was held off last year because of weather concerns. Columbia Township was awarded the South Boone Road Resurfacing Project which will done this year, too.

Subdivision Status – Rundle reported the contractor on Redfern Road did a terrible job on repairs. He said the road is very poor. Chairman Heidecker commented that the developer won't return calls from the Lorain County Engineer.

MS4'S – No complaints or problems reported.

Department Input – Rundle reported that as long as the weather permits, the road crew will continue to do ditching and install culvert pipes. They are also going down each road looking for any hanging branches.

Chairman Heidecker asked if anything was done with the raised monument boxes in Hunting Meadows. Musto said the developer keeps asking DiGioa to fix them, but DiGioa keeps ignoring them.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Personnel – Chief Anthony reported 33 members on file and 32 members on call.

Calls - To date, there have been 4 fire calls and 11 EMS calls.

In 2019, there were 712 EMS calls and 217 Fire calls. Mutual aid was given 64 times and requested 32 times. The department responded to 40 less calls in 2019 than in 2018.

Transport Billing – December 2019 billing receipts totaled \$13,563.41. 2019 ambulance receipts totaled \$154,080.79.

Equipment – Chief Anthony reported all fire equipment up and running.

Department Input – During the Christmas Eve Blood Drive, 33 units of blood were donated. The power went out on Christmas Eve and a lot of people thought it stopped the Blood Drive, but the Fire Station has a generator.

Four blood drives are scheduled in 2020. One will be during the Palm Sunday Pancake Breakfast, two more will be scheduled throughout the year and the final one will be on Christmas Eve.
