Due to efforts to slow the spread of the Covid19 virus, Fiscal Officer Mandie Andrews, Rita Plata, Zoning Inspector Bob Eichenberg and Service Director Bob Rundle did not attend the meeting.

Fire Chief Anthony and Cindy Musto were present. The meeting was open to the public, but no one else attended.

Chairman Heidecker requested approval of the minutes from the regular meeting on March 2, 2020.

Bills and payroll totaling \$107,103.01 were presented for payment.

ZONING INSPECTOR:

Bob Eichenberg was not in attendance. but he gave his report to Trustee Cunningham.

Permits – For February 20 through March 31, 2020, Eichenberg reported issuing 11 permits for three pools, one garage, two barns and five single-family homes.

Violations – Eichenberg is working with Assistant Prosecutor Tom Mangan on the snow plowing business on Station Road. Eichenberg sent a violation notice to a resident on Bryant Avenue for running an auto repair business in a Residential District.

Zoning Commission – Due to Covid19, the Zoning Commission will not meet in April.

Board of Zoning Appeals – The BZA will not meeting in April. There were no applications for this meeting.

Subdivision Status – Nothing new reported

MS4'S – No problems or complaints reported.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Personnel – Chief Anthony reported 34 members on file and 33 members on call.

Calls – To date, there have been 55 Fire calls and 153 EMS calls.

Mutual Aid – Mutual aid has been given 11 times and requested 3 times.

Transport Billing – Billing receipts for the month of March totaled \$14,968.28. Year-to-date receipts total \$40,848.20.

Station Coverage – All hours offered are being covered.

Equipment – Truck 213 is back from W. W. Williams. There was a problem with a switch on the pump. Chief Anthony will have all pump and ladder testing done at the same time.

Department Input – A Blood Drive was held on Palm Sunday and 59 people donated 65 units of blood. Chief offered to do another blood drive at the Fire Station in the future if they want to do one.

Chief Anthony is authorized to work 500 hours in addition to his salary. Anthony may need additional hours due to the additional work involved with Covid19.

Chief Anthony thanked the Columbia Schools for donating a lot of disinfecting supplies.

CEMETERY – Rita Plata did not have any cemetery receipts.
